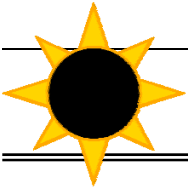

From the Pastor

On August 21st the people of Minnesota will experience the effects of a solar eclipse. It is reported that we in the Twin Cities will view a few hours of partial darkness and not totality as some will view in America. We won't experience total darkness but we will still have eighty three percent of the sun's light diminished around 1 pm. It will be a great event, but you will need to be prepared.

The people of Israel were unprepared for the arrival of Jesus. They had the light of the world walking in their midst, and many denied him. When Jesus hung on the cross they too experienced an eclipse in Jerusalem. For three hours the sky was darkened as God removed his presence from his Son and the weight of our sin was witnessed as darkness. *"And it was now about the sixth hour, and now darkness fell over the whole land until the ninth hour. The sun being obscured and the veil of the temple was torn in two"* (Luke 23:44-45). No longer is God hidden behind the temple curtain. We have access to Him through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Fortunately, as with all eclipses, the darkness never prevails over the light. The light still shines forth even in our sin filled world.

Many will attempt to view the eclipse in America at the moment the sun is totally blocked. Despite the center of the sun being blocked, the light will still shine brightly around the outer edge, What a sight. In order to save your sight, you must be prepared with special glasses.

Even though we live in a world that seemingly prefers

darkness instead of light, we should not be afraid. We who live as children of God, we who live as followers

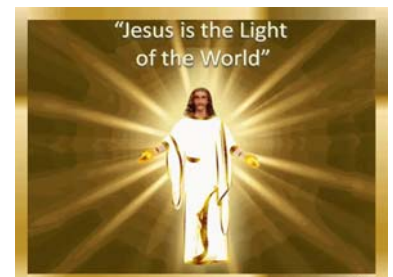

SUNDAY MORNING COFFEE

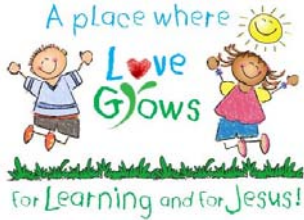
